### Packing List



## GEAR

- PFD - REQUIRED
- Backpack or duffel for your items
- Day pack, dry bag style preferred
- Tent
- Warm sleeping bag
- Sleeping pad
- Personal kitchen kit (utensils, bowl, plate, mug, lighter)
- Water bottle
- 1 bear bin (rent for free from the Girdwood Forest Service office)
- Bear spray

## CLOTHING

- Rain boots- REQUIRED. Calf-high Xtratufs or Muck Boots are great
- Rain jacket and rain pants (bring rubber bibs if you have them)
- Work clothes (non-cotton long pants, long-sleeved shirt for sun and bug protection, work gloves)
- Base layers for extra warmth
- Outer layers (wool, fleece or puffy. Bring extras in case clothing gets wet)
- Extra socks and underwear
- Warm mittens or gloves
- Warm hat
- Sunglasses and hat for sun protection

## TOILETRIES

- Personal toiletries and toilet paper
- Sunscreen
- Bug repellent
- Hand sanitizer / biodegradable soap
- Personal medications and EpiPens

## OPTIONAL ITEMS

- Camera
- Backpacking pillow
- Games Book/journal
- Battery pack
- Emergency preparedness items (med kit, InReach, whistle, emergency blanket, etc.)

- Multitool
- Garbage bag to line backpack for waterproofing
- Bug net
- Backpacking chair
- Hand/feet warmers

***Please do not bring drugs, alcohol, firearms, or drones.***

***Try to keep your items as compact as possible. We need to fit everyone's gear on the vessel.***

***Don't pack more than you need to! We're bringing group gear. Reference the group gear list on the PWSSF Volunteer Adventures page.***

***Do you need to borrow a dry bag? Let us know at least two weeks before the trip departs.***
